Minutes**

1. **Grants:** Gus reported the coalition will receive the same amount from the DBH grant as last year. He will discuss the JSPC's budget at the next coalition meeting.
2. **Follow up to Conference:** This conversation was tabled until after the next Coalition meeting.
3. **Training Opportunities:** This conversation was tabled until after the next Coalition meeting.
4. **Public Awareness Ideas:** Sponsoring the movie "Resilience" when it becomes available to the public was discussed as possible public awareness event.
5. **Suicide Prevention Week:** National Suicide Prevention week is September 5 through September 11, 2016. World Suicide Prevention day is September 10, 2016. All members were encouraged to think of events the JSPC could sponsor to acknowledge these dates. Gayle has initiated conversation with the program director at 360 North TV for airing the first hour of the Dr. Baugher lecture, "Understanding the Suicidal Person" during that week. Suicide Survivor Day is Saturday, November 19. The second hour of Dr. Baugher's lecture covers postvention and could be aired at that time.
6. **Resources- Distribution, Ideas, and Needs:** Gareth agreed to look into what materials might be getting low. Gareth agreed to look into starting a JSPC Facebook page. This would be a resource only page and not be open to public posting. 7. **Other Business:** Gus agreed to work on getting results from the Juneau community ACEs survey published in the Empire and/or Capital City Weekly. This Survey was on SurveyMonkey, discussed at the ACEs conference and advertised in the Capital City Weekly. It was suggested that these results could be sent out to a variety of people including all coalition members and all local primary care providers.
8. **Partner Reports:** Ginny reported that some service hours at the Teen Health Center are being reduced due to cuts in funding.
