**Training Plan:**

**Postvention training-**This event was very well received and several new community partners attended, to include a funeral director, Bartlett ER Social Worker and 2 JPD officers. Notes from the training will be transcribed and shared. This committee will continue to meet and organize their efforts. The Postvention Committee added a couple of new members and will meet quarterly.

**Interfaith Training:** Jan gave a presentation today (4/9/19) and 8 people attended. This was a good outreach as many were interested in learning more about our Postvention training.

**CASA Training** is scheduled for April 23rd and Jan presented a webinar training to the state of Alaska.

**Perseverance Theatre Training:** There was a private performance of Big Bear last weekend at McPhetres Hall, with about 20 people in attendance. JSPC had donated \$750 for their local efforts. Jan held a short training for the cast and crew (lunch and learn) to support their conversations with audience members after each performance. This was very appreciated. Next year JSPC will co-sponsor another performance with Goldbelt, and we'll hold it at the Elizabeth Peratrovich Hall.
