**Training Plan:**

**Postvention training-**April 4th and 5th. Jan sent out an email and is keeping a list of participants. So far, we have ten. Jan will continue to reach out to contact others who may want to attend such as: opioid reduction/substance abuse, JAMHI (Doug or Rachel), Emergency Room nurse or doctor, mortuary, private practice, SEARHC, and emergency response. Hilary stated that she had heard from Officer Weske and Taylor who will be attending. Postvention is still in need of a survivor speaker for the event. Hilary will follow-up with Walter to discuss how the Postvention Plan will be shared at (or before) the training.

**Means Reduction update:** A Work Plan meeting was held and a plan is being created. The goal is to share the work plan with the Steering Committee in April, and share about the efforts at the monthly coalition meeting in May. The next meeting will be held at 3:00 PM, April 9, 2019, before the PA&T meeting at Bartlett. April's meeting is to finish the work plan and structure of the work group. Walter mentioned that at our first meeting, the decision was made to not support the Red Flag bill as we want to stay clear of legislation that removes guns from the house and instead focus on voluntary storage of guns when a person is suicidal.

**Newsletter:** Hannah Laura stated that our numbers (open and click rates) are higher than the national average. Hannah Laura stated that we had 2.7% click rate for March with 224 recipients.
